

Job Page Redesign



The Jobs page has been redesigned with a new side panel providing an 'at-aglance' view of the selected job. This new interface allows for users to quickly browse the details of their jobs without having to open and dismiss dialogs.




Output Config Editor

Choice List: Data Item Binding



In addition to setting Data Items as the default value for Choice Lists at Draft time, users may now *bind* to data item, ensuring that the choice value and the data item value are kept synchronised while editing the Draft document.


- Works for both single selection and multiple selection Data Items
- Works with any type of Data Item
- Multiple bindings supported, providing Choice Relation type functionality


Choice List: Descriptions



Choice List and Choice Descriptions are now exposed separately from the choice title in Draft Editor. This will allow for additional information to be displayed about the Choice or Choice List without using any more screen real estate.


These have also been exposed for editing in Template Editor

This allows for a more forms-oriented user experience when working with Drafts



Choice Lists: Track Net Changes





ONLY THE NET CHANGES ARE REFLECTED IN THE DRAFT EDITOR

Choice Lists can now track Net Changes in Drafts

Changes between Choice List values will only have the *net changes* between the content highlighted as differences, as opposed to the entire choice content being marked as inserted for a newly selected choice, or deselected for an unselected choice.


Minimum/Maximum Values



Draft Editor will now enforce the minimum and maximum values set in the Data Model for dates and numeric values.

This will ensure that any user entered values are within the valid range.

It creates a much more 'form-like' experience for users and simplifies the process of working with Draft documents.




Draft Editor Themes



To help integration within other applications, there is now an additional **light theme** for use with Draft Editor.

The light theme is designed to complement the existing dark theme to provide users the option to select the most appropriate theme for their application.

Themes are configured from the Draft Editor API, with the existing dark theme being the default.



Copy and Paste improvements



Copy and paste from supported versions of Microsoft Word to the Template Editor and Draft Editor has been enhanced:

- New Style matching functionality will attempt to match styles based on matching their names from MS Word and the user's Styleset.
 Headings will be matched based on heading level.
- Copying of Individual Images will now bring the image across to the document. Copying an image and other content will represent the image as a placeholder, allowing the user to quickly upload the image.
- Subscript and Superscript content will match on styles named 'Subscript' and 'Superscript' respectively.




Suggestions



Data Items may now be defined to have **Suggestions**. Similar to Enumerations, Suggestions allow for the user to be presented with a list of possible values. Unlike Enumerations, these values are not exhaustive, and the user may choose their own value for the Data Item by simply typing it in.

Suggestion Data Items are configured within the Data Modeller and can share the same Schema definition as Enumerations, allowing an Enumeration to be turned into a Suggestion for interactive use cases.




Editions Previewer



Template Editor's Preview functionality now allows users to control preview attributes while testing templates

The Messages panel has been redesigned to give a cleaner collapsed view, as well as providing enhanced information including CJP and User Keys

Message level can be defined to hide messages of a low importance



Scriptable Template Selector Editor



Template Designer users can now create and edit Scriptable Template Selectors.

The new editor uses our text editor which is also used within Template Editor including the capabilities of the functions library and allows the user to define multiple scripts relating to each match element they wish to use for their Template Selector.


SC20 Release Highlights

Draft Editor: Right-Click Menu



Draft Editor users may now interact with their Drafts by using the context sensitive right-click menu which presents relevant actions at the mouse pointer position.

This feature is very useful for working with tables, where context sensitive actions can reduce time spent editing.




Draft Editor: Dismiss Exceptions



Users of Exceptions in the Draft Editor can now dismiss individual Exceptions.

This allows for users to keep track of their progress through the Exceptions within their Draft.

The underlying TML can be postprocessed as part of the external user workflow ensuring that critical parts of the document are actioned by the user.




Data Item Change History



Improved representation of document edit history—previously updates were recorded as deletions and insertions.

All changes to a data item are now wrapped inside the same change element.

This improves the Draft as a tool for data capture and also facilitates much more robust data extraction.



Template Editor: Side Panel



The side panel in Template Editor has been redesigned using our *SmartUI* user interface design language. Users can work more efficiently with the new, cleaner Side Panel interface.



Improved Export and Import




Project Dashboard Export now supports folder export.

All Exports now have two new options:

- To select only released resource versions
- To select related resources

Export and Import dialogs have had their interfaces improved.



Template Editor: Advanced If Rules



Users can now create Advanced If Rules within the Template Editor using JavaScript.


This allows users to utilize the SmartCOMM function library as well as any custom functions defined in their Document Script or Script Library.



HTML Preview Area Mouse Resize



When previewing HTML templates, users are now able to use the mouse to resize the preview, allowing them to quickly mimic the screen resolution of any device.




Template Editor: Automated PDF Bookmarking



Template Editor users can configure their Templates to now automatically create Bookmarks in their PDF Output.

Bookmarks can be configured to be generated on individual Sections and Enclosures, or they can be applied to all Sections and Enclosures through the use of a Channel Job Property.



For Advanced Template Designer (ATD) users, this new functionality requires the latest SC20 ATD to be installed to preserve customized Section names.


Support for OAuth 2.0



All public APIs can be accessed in a secure fashion using the OAuth 2.0 authentication standard.

This will provide support for those customers who are routing requests through a Web Proxy that only supports OAuth 2.0 and third-party applications which only have OAuth 2.0 support.

OAuth 1.0 is still fully supported and in many cases is still preferred.



This new functionality will be made available in a patch release of the product.


